



SEATING AREA

Chairs may be arranged banquet, classroom, or theatre style, but try to avoid a "chevron" arrangement. Leave at least one central aisle. Please keep the front row of chairs *close* to the stage, allowing only enough room for a person to comfortably walk between the front row and stage (about 4 feet). Please put up only as many chairs as you realistically expect to fill. This prevents the front rows from being left empty.

SOUND TABLE AREA

Please place the sound table (wireless receivers, CD player, mixer board, two chairs) anywhere in the room EXCEPT on the stage, behind the stage, or in the "No Sit Areas". Try to use a CD player that has a time code counter on it.
